Special Announcement

Clarification about "Abstain Vote"

- We give thanks for the smooth process of the AGM last Sunday. We would like to clarify on a point of confusion about whether or not "abstain votes" should be counted.
- During the AGM, Pastor Alan ruled that abstain votes should not be counted and the 75% needed for the passing of a motion should be understood as 75% of only the "approve" and "oppose" votes combined. This is based on the Robert's Rule of Order, which according to our bylaw 10.8, should be the authority for the conduct of all business meetings of the congregation.
- Bylaw 10.9.1 about the requirement for the calling of pastors actually specifically says 75% majority of those "present and voting" is required. According to Robert's Rule of Order, those who "voted abstain" have in fact "not voted" by definition (the very thing that they have

- "abstained" from is "voting"). So Pastor Alan's ruling stands. However, this may not be the understanding of every member of the congregation. Pastor Alan apologized for the confusion caused.
- Either way, since Pastor Patrick has received 97 votes, he has passed the 75% threshold whether we count the total votes as 128 or less. This dispute will not change the result of the voting. Yet the pastoral team is concerned about the high number of oppose and abstain votes. If you would like to discuss your opinion on this motion, you are invited to talk to any pastor or deacon. You have our ears.
