Parking

- 5. Why do you think Jesus gave his disciples authority over demons and diseases before sending them out? What does this say about our mission today?
- 6. Why do you think Jesus paired the disciples in Luke 10:1? What are the benefits of serving in partnership?
- 7. What are some misconceptions people have about following Jesus, based on the responses of the three men in Luke 9:57-62?

- 8. Jesus had no home (Luke 9:58). How does this challenge our expectations of what a good and stable life should look like?
- 9. How do Jesus' words challenge a "comfortable" or "easy" Christianity?
- 10. In what ways have you experienced friction between following Jesus and the expectations of the world?
- 11. Jesus promised his disciples power and authority. How have you experienced God's power in your own life?

12. What are the hindrances (including internal and external) for you to be and make disciple? What are the effective ways to remove these hindrances? Please ask your group members for advice.

- 13. Resolve to be and make disciple. Share how practically you'll do this with your group members.
- 14. Invite a group member to be your accountability partner, and give him/her permission to rebuke you when you have not followed through on your resolution.
- 15. Commit to God your resolution to be and make disciple. Ask the Holy Spirit to mould you into more like Jesus.
