Scripture Reading Plan

- ► This week's Bible reading plan begins with 1
 Timothy and Titus, followed by 2 Timothy. These
 letters are commonly known as the Pastoral
 Epistles, because the recipients, Timothy and Titus,
 were entrusted with pastoral responsibilities. Paul
 had a close relationship with Timothy, whom he
 called his beloved and faithful son, while Titus
 was a Gentile convert to Christ who became Paul's
 coworker. 1 Timothy discusses church ministry and
 leadership, Titus focuses on the conduct expected
 of Christians, and all the Pastoral Epistles address
 false teachings and false teachers.

- 4. Read together again 1Timothy 4:6-16. What impression does this passage give you? What is the most intriguing saying in this passage to you? Why?
- 5. Why does Paul emphasize both teaching sound doctrine and training in godliness?
- 6. What does it mean to "train yourself to be godly"?

Feel

- 7. How do you feel when you consider that your personal spiritual growth affects others in the community?
- 8. What emotions come up when you think about being a "model" for others in faith and integrity?
- 9. Have you ever experienced inspiration from seeing someone else's spiritual maturity? How did it affect you?
- 10. When have you felt most connected to the church community in your spiritual journey?
- 11. What fears or hesitations do you have about letting others share in your spiritual life?
- 12. How does the "porcupine dilemma" (the pain of closeness vs. the danger of isolation) describe your experience in relationships?

Plan

13. What are the hindrances (including internal and external) for you to connect spiritually to other Christ-followers in your faith community? What are the effective ways to remove these hindrances? Please ask your group members for advice.

Do

- 14. Resolve to connect spiritually to other Christfollowers in your faith community. Share how practically you'll do this with your group members.
- 15. Invite a group member to be your accountability partner, and give him/her permission to rebuke you when you have not followed through on your resolution.
- 16. Commit to connect spiritually to other Christfollowers in your faith community. Ask the Holy Spirit to mould you more into the likeness of Jesus.
